Sustainability Initiatives



Sustainability Initiatives are defined* as "Programs / systems / organizations designing and / or implementing tools and approaches to advance / promote / enhance sustainability in value chain activities".

Examples of sustainability initiatives include:

- Voluntary sustainability standards, codes of conduct, audit protocol,
- Reporting initiatives, benchmarking systems, ESG rating programs, corporate sustainability programs,
- Sustainable public policies, international social and environmental norms or conventions, guidance and good practices, due diligence frameworks and any related social and environmental programs.




Sustainability Initiatives: Voluntary Sustainability Standards



"Voluntary sustainability standards (VSS) are standards specifying requirements that producers, traders, manufacturers, retailers or service providers may be asked to meet, relating to a wide range of sustainability metrics, including respect for basic human rights, worker health and safety, environmental impacts, community relations, land-use planning and others."

Sustainability Initiatives: Voluntary Sustainability Standards



- "VSS and Codes of Conduct are mostly designed and marketed by nongovernmental organizations (NGOs) or private firms
- They are adopted by actors up- and downstream of the value chain, from farmers to retailers.
- VSS and Codes of Conduct sometimes use certifications and labels to signal their successful implementation
- Both have become a market reality and non-compliance with certain VSS or Codes of Conduct can lead to the exclusion of producers from global value chains








Sustainability Initiatives: Voluntary Sustainability Standards



Market trends of certified forests and two VSS




